**Management Aptitude Test(MAT)**

**Dear Prof Bhattacharyya,**

Please refer to your letter dated 11 March 2008.

Management Aptitude Test is a standardized test being used by hundreds of B-Schools for screening the candidates for admission to their MBA and allied programmes both in India and abroad. Several lakhs of candidates take the test every year. The annual registration for MAT is more than that for CAT at the national level or that for GMAT at international level.

The eligibility for appearing in MAT is graduation from recognized university. The final year students of graduate programmes are also eligible to appear in MAT. Under the scheme of MAT the candidates are provisionally permitted to appear in MAT based on their application. Hence there is no restriction on graduates of University of Bradford to appear in MAT. However, the prerogative of the eligibility verification rests with the institute imparting Post Graduate Programme in Management.
